Club Information

Mawdesley Juniors Football Club was established in 2018 by a group of local parents who aspire to set up a community football club for our children to be part of. The aim and vision of our club are that all children can play football in a safe and friendly environment. The club provides a setting for children to have fun with their friends whilst developing their technical, social, psychological and physical skills in line with the FA's recommended way of learning.

The club is run entirely by volunteers with coaches for each age group, and a committee who meets regularly to drive the club forward; all have undertaken the relevant training to perform their role. We are always keen to hear from parents who would like to volunteer some of their time to help in these club roles or to assist at training sessions.

The club hold a training session for an hour each week in the evening and plays matches against other local teams at the weekend. The games' days, times and locations vary for each age group, so please get in touch with the team manager for more details.

Format of Matches

Youth football is structured so that it begins with small-sided 5-a-side matches for under 7s, slowly building to 7 and then 9-a-side before reaching 11-a-side at under 13s. This encourages children to learn and develop confidence; research suggests that children's development improves early with more time and touches with the ball.

Mawdesley Juniors Football Club and the leagues in which they participate are FA Charter Standard and promote and enforce the FA 'Respect' code of conduct for all players, managers and parents, which will be shared with you in due course. You must read this before the first match to understand your role as a parent/spectator and your child's playing responsibilities.

Subscriptions

Each season for the club is August to July, for the 2024/25 season the club charges the following monthly subscriptions;

Type	Monthly Subscription
Player, no siblings	£24
Trainer, no siblings	£18
Player with sibling that is also a player	£12
Trainer with a sibling that is either a player or a trainer	£9

These fees are subject to change at the start of every new season where agreed by the Committee. The subscriptions cover all costs of hiring pitches for training sessions, equipment, insurance, match day, welfare, competitions and referee fees. Note that the club is not-for-profit, any surpluses made go back to the club for the benefit of the children.

A standing order is required, with payment due on the 1st day of each month for every month of the year or a payment made for the full year (12 months) in August.

We may send invoices for each months subscription, where this is the case the Parent/Guardian (1) Email will be used.

Leaving the club

We understand that there will be instances where a child will leave the club. In these circumstances a parent / guardian must inform the club treasurer by e-mail at treasurer@mawdesleyjuniorsfc.co.uk with one months' notice (if a child is to leave at the end of April then the April and May subscriptions will be payable).

We smooth the cost of subscriptions over a 12 month period to make it easier for parents. As such if a child is to leave the club in May or June payments must be made to include the July subscription.

Non-Payment of Subscriptions

As a not-for-profit club we rely on the fees payable by parents to be able to fund the facilities and enable your child, or children, to have the best chance of enjoying sport in a safe environment.

If for any reason an account becomes overdue the parent will be issued with a statement of account showing the monies due. If accounts remain overdue for 3 months or more then the club reserves the right to refuse admission to any of the facilities offered.
